**A new Airbus A330 Aircraft joins the Alitalia fleet servicing long-haul routes.  
The aircraft will serve on North American routes as well as between Italy and Alitalia's new  
intercontinental destinations: Rio de Janeiro and Beijing.**

*April 21, 2011-* On April 22, 2011, a new Airbus A330 aircraft joined Alitalia's fleet, the fourth A330 received since July 2010.

The aircraft, which has been named "Canaletto," will operate from Miami and New York to Rome and Milan, and beginning June 1, 2011, will also operate from Rome Fiumicino to Rio de Janeiro and Beijing, Alitalia's newest intercontinental destinations.

The aircraft is configured with three cabins and accommodates 224 passengers: a Magnifica cabin with 28 seats that convert to fully flat beds; the new Classica Plus cabin, Alitalia's premium economy service introduced in 2010 with a capacity of 21 seats; and Classica, Alitalia's renovated economy class cabin with 175 seats.

With a range of 13,400 Km and the latest generation engines designed to allow for a significant reduction in fuel consumption and CO2 emission, the new A330s exemplify the standards that Alitalia has set for the operating efficiency of its fleet.

The investment plan to renovate Alitalia's fleet, currently one of the youngest among the European carriers, will continue throughout 2011 with the introduction of additional long-haul A330 aircraft, medium haul Airbus aircraft and new Embraer 175's and 190's, which are scheduled to be delivered to Alitalia during the second half of 2011.
